

VOLUNTEER SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE INDIVIDUAL COMMITMENT

Triathlon Victoria (TV) is committed to safeguarding children and young people (children) in its care. As part of this commitment we have developed a TV Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy (Policy) and a TV Child Safety Code of Conduct (Code) for our organisation.

All volunteers directly engaged by TV, are required to commit to and abide by our Policy and Code. Furthermore, we require you to immediately report any breaches of the Code by other volunteers and/ or employees that you become aware of.

Management considers a failure to commit to and abide by our Code to be misconduct, which will result in appropriate action. Action may include suspension while matters are investigated and/or dismissal. In addition to any internal disciplinary proceedings, any breaches of the law will be reported to the police.

Volunteer Commitment

As a volunteer associated with Western Suburbs Triathlon Club, you;

- Understand and fully support TV's commitment statement to Child Safety;
- Have been provided with a copy, have read, and have understood the 'TV Child Safety Code of Conduct';
- Understand my responsibilities in relation to ensuring and promoting the safety of children, and my expected behaviour towards and in the presence of children;
- Will commit to and abide by the Guidelines during my time volunteering with TV to ensure and promote the safety of children and young people participating in any program or events provided by TV;
- Understand that I must report any criminal conviction or charge that may indicate I pose a potential risk to children in accordance with the TV Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy.
